





FLOOR PLAN BHIRAJ HALL, SILK, NILE, AMBER

PARKING REGULATION



- All decorations or constructions must be semi-finished structures.
- The height of the standard booth and special booth on the 2nd floor (GRAND HALL, BHIRAJ HALL) must be at most 3.5 meters. The meeting room must be 2.5 meters, and the Concourse must be 3 meters.

- The floor load for the 2nd floor is 200 kg./sq.m. For equipment, products, or machines to be exhibited, weight must not exceed 200 kg./sq.m.
- The exhibitor must submit the machine perspective with an engineer (Professional Engineer/Associate Engineer) and is required to submit it to the Official Freight Forwarder of the organizer for approval at least 30 days before the move-in period.


Remark: Details of hanging equipment and products on display must be submitted to customer service staff for review and approval always.



- Rigging Point, the Main beam can support not exceed 200 kg. / point and the whole main shaft can support notes exceeding 2,000 kilograms. / beam and Sub beam can help not exceed 100 kg. / point and fundamental sub-beam can keep messages exceeding 1,000 kilograms. / beam
- Working on high ground, the Contractor must have a safety harness helmet and lanyard. Please inform the organizer and exchange cards with staff in the security room (behind the building) before accessing the high-ground



For lighting and speakers truss, the Contractor or Exhibitor must inform the truss design rigging plot of the total weight of hanging all equipment and is required to submit to the organizer for further approval at <u>least 14 days</u> before move-in.









Truss with construction, Contractor, or Exhibitor must submit the perspective, including rigging plot and total weight of hanging equipment, with an engineer (Professional Engineer/Associate Engineer) and required to submit to the organizer for further approval at least 14 days before move-in.







HANGING POINT BHIRAJ HALL





- All construction must be supported by carpet to Protect the floor.
- Not allowed glue or unaccepted adhesive tape is to be used in laying the carpet or any other materials on the Centre's floor. Only residue-resistant tape is allowed.
- Adhesive tape used to decorate the floor or carpet must be thick carpet tape.









Do not obstruct or block the fire exit, entrance area, aisle, electrical control panel, fire hose cabinet, and fire alarm.







Do not place boxes and other stock behind the gap between booth and hall partition. For safety reasons**





Electric sewing in the event hall is prohibited; only handsaw are afforded and must be covered by a floor covering for scrap material.



The painting, colour-mixed tinner and spray are prohibited. A sander machine with a vacuum tube is required for sandpaper to avoid the smell of colour and dust.

If you are not the addressee you are prohibited from copying it, distributing it or disclosing it to anyone other than the addressee.



Trash and garbage from construction or demonstrated during the show. The exhibitor or contractor must take care and remove all trash, garbage or any left over materials out of the BITEC area.


































Do not allow to bring in the flammable before approval from BITEC.



The Helium, Argon, Nitrogen, and Carbon Dioxide permission are required to be brought in and must be locked with a stable rack. The fire extinguisher is nearby for safety reasons.






Do not allow cleaning up all equipment and throwing out hazardous liquid in a toilet because hazardous liquid must be correctly termed via the treatment tank before being thrown out. The dangerous liquid in the utility system may be harmful, including bringing water from the toilet for the exhibit.



Do not allow the installation of the high-pressure air compressor in the exhibit area. If the air compressor system is installed, the exhibitor or contractor must order from the official contractor.

















Do not allow to convert electrical system without power distributor. In case Improper or hazardous electrical installations must be fixed immediately.







- Electric wiring must have clearly signal.
- Do not use extension cord. In case of overload
































In an automobile, the supply must be at most 1/8 of the fuel tank and remove all cables, batteries and tape properly. Electrical system wiring for exhibit vehicles must comply with safety standards.











Requires for Installation overtime: Contractors or Exhibitors must inform the organizer before 20.00 hrs for further preparation and coordination. The overtime rate will be calculated after move-in time.

*These prices do not include electric power.



Utilities will be "turn off" after the event period. (Unless the official contractor has notified BITEC that you have ordered extended utility service or power socket for 24 hours.) BITEC is not responsible if your equipment or products are damaged after the system shutdown.













- Children are not allowed to enter the event area during the move-in and moveout period.
- Animals or Pets are not allowed to enter the event area during the move-in and move-out period.
- Smoking is not allowed indoors and only allowed in designated areas.
- Drinking is strictly prohibited during the move-in and move-out period.
- Slippers are not permitted in the event area during the move-in and move-out period.



Requirements for using Gantry Lift




Dimension of gantry lift 3x6x3 m. (Width x Length x High)

GANTRY LIFT

- All rights reserved, only in cases where the structure, size and weight exceed what an average lift can support.
- Can bear weight not more than 5,000 Kg.
- The time allowed for use is <u>5-7 am</u> and time that does not affect other events that are being exhibited
- The application form must be submitted 7 days in advance.
- Inquire for additional terms and conditions of use from Customer service in charge.




LOCATION OF LIFTS FOR LOADING






ROUTES GUIDE to Welcome Hall Loading (B1 Floor)






ROUTES GUIDE to Welcome Hall Loading (B1 Floor)






LOCATION OF LIFTS FOR LOADING






DIMENSION FOR LOADING DOOR BHIRAJ HALL





ROUTES GUIDE to LOADING BAY







- Loading bays should not be use for parking. After loading or unloading is completed, vehicles must leave the area within limited time.
- Loading or unloading through the glass doors in front of the building is prohibited. The route to unload the product must be from the loading bay only.
- BITEC is not responsible for any damage, or loss of personal property before, during and after work.















LOADING BAY PARKING FEE

Car/4-Wheel vehicles First 1 ½ hours free of charge

More than 6-wheel vehicle. First 3 hours free of charge

Succeeding hours 200 baht/hour

In the event that the card is lost there will be a fine 1.000 Baht

(Payment can be made at the card accepting kiosk.)






ROUTES GUIDE to MARSHALING YARD






ROUTES GUIDE to INDOOR PARKING



DEBARATNA ROAD




ROUTES GUIDE in BASEMENT AREA

PARKING RULES & REGULATION





- Red Card for parking indoor free for the first 30 minutes
- Dark Blue Card for parking outdoor free for the first 3 hours
- Parking fees for both indoor and outdoor is 20 Baht/hour
- The parking lot open from 6 a.m. to midnight. Overnight parking is not allow.
- In case of overtime parking will be charge 100 Baht/hour.
 - In the event that the card is lost there will be a fine 1.000 Baht (Payment can be made at the card accepting kiosk.)



PARKING FEE at OFFICE BUILDING



- Car Blue Card Basement Area is free for the first 30 minutes.
- Succeeding hours 30 baht/hour (a fraction of an hour will be rounded up to 1 hour)
- The parking lot open from 6 a.m. to midnight. Overnight parking is not allow.
- In case of overnight parking will be charge 500 Baht/hour.
- In the event that the card is lost there will be a fine 1,000 Baht (Payment can be made at the card accepting kiosk.)



- Motorcycle Blue Card Basement Area is free for the first 30 minutes.
- Succeeding hours 10 baht/hour (a fraction of an hour will be rounded up to 1 hour)
- The parking lot open from 6 a.m. to midnight. Overnight parking is not allow.
- In case of overnight parking will be charge 300 Baht/hour.
- In the event that the card is lost there will be a fine 1,000 Baht (Payment can be made at the card accepting kiosk.)
